

### **Congressional District Caucus Meetings**

Tuesday May 7th at 7 p.m. Via Zoom

One of the responsibilities of state convention delegates is to elect delegates to the National Convention in August. On Tuesday state delegates will caucus by congressional district to hear from the candidates running to be a district-level. The Zoom link will be emailed to state delegates by the South Carolina Democratic Party by Monday.

Under the SCDP Delegate Selection Plan, no more than half the delegates from a Congressional District may be from any one county. Also, Congressional District delegates must be evenly divided by gender. The candidates who are running to be Congressional District delegates are listed below.

Election of these delegates will take place online and by telephone on Wednesday May 8th from 9 a.m. until 9 p.m. Ballots will be emailed to state delegates.


